FREE PART-TIME PARTICIPATION IN THE AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITY PROGRAMME (ACTIVITY SCHOOL) FOR YEARS 1 to 4 IN THE 2023/2024 SCHOOL YEAR

We are offering all children starting in Years 1 to 4 part-time participation free of charge in the Activity School for the 2023/2024 school year. You can take advantage of this offer from August 2023.

What is free part-time participation in the Activity School?

- Part-time participation means 12 hours per week after school.
 This provides children with a predictable schedule and ensures that the school can provide a high-quality programme.
- Part-time participation also includes two days per week during school holidays. Autumn and winter holidays, Christmas and Easter holidays, and in each week of the summer holidays (except July). The Activity School is closed in July.
- On school planning days, or days off between an official public holiday and a weekend during the school year, your child may attend the Activity School for a half day.

However, the Activity School may be closed on up to two school planning days per year.

If you would like to register your child for full-time participation in the Activity School, you can apply for full-time participation at a reduced price.

Full-time participation at a reduced price

The price for full-time participation varies, depending on the income of each child's parents/guardians. The maximum monthly cost will not exceed NOK 1,108. Full-time participation means that your child may attend the Activity School both before and after school hours, as well as all days during school holidays (except July).

How to apply for a place in the Activity School
