

INFORMATION: AKS (after school activities) at Lakkegata Skole

AKS is a service for everyone in 1st to 4th grade. There is a variety of activities that the children can take part in from the end of school, until we close at 17:00. With a full-time plan, your child is also able to attend AKS before school, from 07:30 until 08:30.

AKS has two different types of plans. The first one is part-time. This allows your child to attend AKS for 12 hours per week. This plan is free of use for 1st, 2nd and 3rd graders. For 4th graders this plan is free if your household has a combined yearly income below 1 500 000, - NOK. The full-time plan allows your child to attend AKS for all its opening hours, including before school, and until AKS closes at 17:00. The price of a full-time plan is dependent on the household's total income. Below is a breakdown of how much you'll pay per month at different levels of income.

During school vacations, AKS is open. With a part-time plan your child is allowed to attend Mondays and Wednesdays. With a full-time plan your child is allowed to attend the entire week. Food at AKS

Every day after school, all pupils receive a light meal. This is included in the monthly price and comes at no additional cost. There is no meat that gets served, but we use dairy products. During holidays, there is no food served, and the children are therefore required to have two meals with them.

There are some activities with external suppliers in-house, and at other venues that may require parental accept. These will either be sent home with the kids, for your signature or sent digitally through the parent portal (Vigilo). We will never offer activities that require additional payment.

How do you attend and go home from AKS?

When school ends, one of our employees checks in the pupils that are attending AKS, in the classroom. If your child is not attending, there either has to be an agreement in place that your child can leave whenever they desire. This agreement can be on a daily basis, or as an agreement on a permanent basis. It's also possible to have a set time for your child to leave each day. If your child does not go home by themselves, and is getting picked up, the one picking them up must do so at the counter. The counter is in front of the library, which is right inside the door of the middle entrance of the main building. If someone other than the parent is picking up your child, we must have written notification of this.
